The Drowning Prevention Coalition (DPC) was established in 1996 to reduce drowning, non-fatal drowning and other water-related incidents by educating the public on water safety and basic rescue techniques. The DPC is funded by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners and the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County, with the DPC being housed and managed by Palm Beach County Fire Rescue.

The Coalition is partnering with Channel 20 to provide educational programming to Palm Beach County residents on how to be water safe and water smart year-round.

DPC is a primary resource for Palm Beach County residents and visitors' water safety needs. We offer information about local pools, layers of protection, swimming instruction, lifeguarded areas, and more.

The Drowning Prevention Coalition is committed to expanding its water safety educational initiatives by providing free, virtual and land-based water safety education to audiences of all ages. DPC provides educational displays at health and safety fairs and provides free/reduced cost swimming lessons to qualified families, and guiding groups and special needs programs to area swimming lessons.

Remove or Cut: yours and your children's who can't help themselves.

Capable children should remove their seatbelt and exit through open window. Push out younger children ahead of you and exit behind them.

HAVE AN ESCAPE TOOL AVAILABLE

Some Common Tools









- Having a tool may increase your chances of survival.
- Make sure you have a certified and tested escape tool.
- Tools can be bought in hardware stores, auto supply shops, and online.
- Read the manufacturer's instructions on how to properly handle the tool and learn how to use it in advance.
- Keep tool within reach (i.e. on keychain, mounted on driver's side door, or in a covered center console) – Not in the glove box or trunk!

REHEARSE EMERGENCY ESCAPE AND SURVIVAL PROCEDURES WITH YOUR PASSENGER(S) AND HAVE AN ESCAPE TOOL READILY AVAILABLE.

FACTS



Be Informed

- Motor vehicle crashes in canals are the third leading cause of drowning in Palm Beach County. (FL Medical Examiner, District 15)
- You must ESCAPE WITHIN the 1st MINUTE after a car enters the water!
- Float times of a vehicle can vary between 30 seconds and a few minutes depending on several factors such as the vehicle's weight, design, seals, and structural damage on impact.
- Electric windows may work for a short period of time and should be opened as quickly as possible.
- Don't take anything heavy or unnecessary with you as you escape. In this situation, your life and the lives of those around you are most important.

LAMINATED vs. TEMPERED WINDOW GLASS

- Hammer-type devices and spring-loaded window punches are NOT effective on laminated glass. Most front car windshields are made of laminated glass.
- If glass is tempered, use an escape tool in a bottom corner of a side window for breakage.
- Check your vehicle's manual or contact your car's manufacturer to determine vehicle's glass type.



15 Year Anniversary of the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General

This year marks the fifteenth anniversary of the Palm Beach County Office of Inspector General (OIG) along with the Commission on Ethics, our partner in promoting integrity in local government. In November 2010, 72% of the voters approved a countywide referendum to amend the County Charter and permanently establish the OIG. A majority of voters in each of the 38 municipalities within Palm Beach County that existed at the time approved an expansion of OIG jurisdiction to cover all municipalities within the county.

Today, the OIG jurisdiction covers the County government,¹ the 39 municipalities of Palm Beach County, and other entities that contract with the OIG (currently the Solid Waste Authority and the Children's Services Council). Our mission is to promote integrity,

efficiency, and effectiveness in government in order to enhance public trust in government, and to provide independent and objective insight, oversight, and foresight through audits, investigations, contract oversight, reviews, and outreach activities.

During the past fifteen years, we identified over **82 million** dollars in questioned costs and potential cost savings, made over **1,300 recommendations to make government better**, and referred **736 cases to law enforcement, and County or State Commissions on Ethics.** Twenty-four arrests or prosecutions came as a direct result of our work here in the OIG.



I want to thank the OIG staff for their commitment and professionalism in serving the citizens of Palm Beach County. Additionally, I want to thank the Inspector General Committee for its continued encouragement and insights. Another factor in our success has been the support from leaders in the County and municipal governments, the Solid Waste Authority, and the Children's Services Council.

Finally, you, the citizens of Palm Beach County, continue to be the bedrock supporters of our office and mission. Public support and input is critical to our mission success. 



