Ms. Moguillansky suggests that the residents can help by talking to the property owner. Mr. \_\_\_\_\_ say they will be meeting this week and if there is any problems he will let Ms. Moguillansky know. Ms. Moguillansky asks if there is any questions. - Going back to San Castle on the bids, weren't they completed and out for bid about last month? answered that they have the plans from the consultant and are making final comments. Ruth says she will need the amount of money that has been spent on project for the One Million Dollar \_\_\_\_\_, Ms. Moguillansky needs the money that has already been spent and the estimated time of completion of the project. Stated that they got \$250,000 for Lake Worth and \$200,000 for San Castle. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that plans that are being funded for the \$250,000 have all been funded through the Commissioners. Moguillansky asks 430,000 and \_\_\_\_\_ replies "Yeah, they've all been funded by the Commissioners." Ms. Moguillansky says they have to completely show \_\_\_\_\_ September 21st. Stephen McGrew is pleased the amount to report that the Lake Worth corridor sewer project has been advertised and prepared to proceed the bids this week. That half million dollar project is mainly on the south side of Lake Worth Road from Kirk to Congress they are putting in sewer \_\_\_\_\_ pressurized pipe & commercial properties could tie into that. They were looping down Congress Ave to the south. Royal Palm Estates area and the majority of the water mane in the contractor is now working on the water service for each lot. Looking at late summer when the property of each connection come in. On May 15th Board of County Commissioner Public Hearing there was a project called the Congress Ave. area, which is a CCRT area. Streets that are northern Forest Hill and on East side of Congress between Forest Hill and Summit. Project that is out to bid with Allen Webb is Coconut Road, putting water manes and will receive \$50,000 worth of funding from CCRT. When Allen receive the bids and when they get the tabulation for the water mane items then the connection will be accomplished. Recently did a special assessment master plan, in which the maps were looked at all the areas which currently not served with county water and there is maybe about 350 to 400 streets and giving up to a five year plan which was approved by the advisory board. Will be doing a proactive program from east to west so that we could go to people and initiate the petition process instead of waiting for them to come to us. Plan needs to be worked with whatever funding is available through the CCRT. Looking at cost estimate now and funding opportunity coming up. If there is potential to reduce the assess man, we would like to know before we go and send petitions. Last item is Stacy Street. Code Enforcement: Skipping issue at this time

GCommunity Policing Status Report: Jim Hightower states that Lake Belvedere Estates have made some arrangements to work with Code Enforcement to do a project in Lake Belvedere and has gotten out of hand. Code violations have gotten bad. This is one of the neighbors that was considered in our 37 neighborhoods overall. Jim wants to complement both Code Enforcement and Mike for work they did in neighborhood called Sleepy Hollow which is mobile park that is occupied by mostly retirees. Recently in the last 2 to 3 years, drug dealers have moved in and really have made living stressful for the remaining retirees. Code Enforcement and Mike came in and within 30 days one of the trailers was condemned. \_\_\_\_\_ states that the mobile homes fall through the cracks in terms of some of the grant opportunities. also states that Sleepy Hollow might be a good place to have CCRT funding. states that they will expand on Paint Your Heart Out and will try to make it a year round project. \_\_\_\_\_ reports that Lake Worth \_\_\_\_ is slowing down and made three arrests last week. \_\_\_\_\_ reports that they have completed the analysis and the surveying for Country Club Acres and look forward to meeting with \_\_\_\_\_ a week from the 11th. \_\_\_\_ says that they have been talking to the residents about water mane project and would like to get a letter prior to the 11th formally asking us to come because Country Club Acres is an area that may be in dispute for the City of Delray Beach. Ruth asks Tim if there is anything that has happened from last meeting until now. Tim answers that in regards to San Castle they have a conversation with Steve Cramer, County Administration to let them know that Headstart was looking for a land in San Castle.
