 - Youth Services are currently preparing for their summer camp scholarship program, which is funded by the board of county commissioners to pay for tuition and fees for summer camps throughout the county, so that parents have a safe and nurturing environment for their children to go to. To date, there are 98 camp sites. Youth Services is currently reviewing the parent applications for the program. The camps can be from 8 to 10 weeks. Registration for the camp closed on April 16th. To date, 4,118 scholarships have been processed for the summer camp.
