A. Presentation of CARE Award

B. Ryan White Reauthorization PowerPoint: David Begley:

- The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Modernization Act stipulates that it will no longer be called the CARE Act; Title I is now Part A and Title II is now Part B.
- **Funding:** Formula funding (which will be based on <u>actual</u> AIDS cases not HIV no estimates) will now amount to just over 66% (2/3) of the total and the Supplemental funding will be just over 33% (1/3) of the total as opposed to it's previous 50%.
- 75% of the funding will be allocated to Core Medical Services and 25% to Support Services. These percentages are after 10% and 5% go to the Grantee and Quality Management, respectively, and there will be no specific line item for Program Support or CARE Council Support as those funds will come out of the 15% noted above.
- Residential Substance Abuse Treatment will now be considered a Support Service and Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment will be a Core Medical Service.
- MIA is now a competitive process which will operate on a separate fiscal year, August Ist through July 3 Ist. The final regulations regarding MIA are being awaited.
