- VIII. Educational Moment: Rechee Huff presented and took questions and comments regarding the HOPWA Program. She recommended sharing housing ideas not only with HOPWA but also with mayors and commissioners to enact change. The Council discussed the possibility of reviewing the HOPWA waitlist, housing capacity and expenditures on a quarterly basis in addition to the current standing reports.
