## Financially Assisted Agencies (FAA) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for Senior Housing FY 2020

## **Questions & Answers**

- 1. What is the total funding amount available?
  - The total funding available is \$100,000.00.
- 2. Is housing-focused case management a part of the strategy?
  - Yes, it is mentioned in both of the strategies for homeless prevention and homelessness. The NOFO has a definition for housing-focused case management.
- 3. Would agencies say how they work with the coordinated entry process?
  - Yes, agencies should identify how they work with coordinated entry.
- 4. Is this NOFO aimed at assisting seniors who can already afford housing?
  - If the senior cannot afford housing on their own with their fixed income, we are asking the agencies to identify the roommate-matching element that they will implement to help alleviate this burden by sharing the cost between two seniors.
- 5. I was unable to locate the grant application from your website prior to attending the bidder's conference. Will it be uploaded today?
  - The Bidder's Conference NOFO document has been posted to the FAA website http://discover.pbcgov.org/communityservices/financiallyassisted/Pages/RFP.aspx.
- 6. In SAMIS, is the total amount that is possible to be requested \$200,000, or the \$100,000 for FY 2020? I know the intention is to issue a 2-year contract, but should the amount requested reflect one year or two?
  - Submit your annual request and align your budget to that. \$100K would be the max you could request and budget for.
- 7. Does FAA have a goal (or a range) that they can share regarding the number of seniors to be served on an annual basis by the \$100,000?
  - No FAA does not. That is up to the agency to decide based on the outline of their program.

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
