- I. Welcome and Opening Comments Chairman Martz
- II. Introductions were made.
- III. The agenda and minutes were approved by consent.

IV. Business:

- a. Branding and Informational Campaign Update Stephen Plunk, Graphic Designer, Plunk Designs presented several options for the logo and explained the meaning behind the design. There was a discussion about the options and the name of the site. The group approved the design and decided to add Palm Beach County under the logo and to look at the logo with several taglines such as "Keeping Us Safe". A vote was held to determine the name of the site with 7 in agreement of "Be Aware and Care" and 4 in favor of "Aware and Care".
- b. Sharon L'Herrou, President/CEO, 211 Palm Beach/Treasure Coast provided a general update. She advised that they competed nationally for a grant award for suicide chat. They also received funding to hire two peer navigators. Information was provided about the lifeline training requirements. She noted that 211 responded to 85,000 requests for help last year and they answered 90% of calls within less than a minute.
- c. Kristina Henson advised that the CJC will need to postpone these committee meetings for two months to complete a review of the PBSO Work Release program.
- d. Chairman Martz provided an overview of the July 20th Active Shooter Drill held at Florida Atlantic University. He advised that the event went well with approximately 300 law enforcement and 150 students that participated. There were several areas that could be addressed such as unity of command. He also noted the importance of having someone assigned to the command center that could provide detailed information about the site such as best access routes.
