We reviewed the original goals of the Task Force and suggested that the new goals should be to "Raise awareness about the use and misuse of jails and to solicit feedback on this collective effort."

We should focus on the following in 2019:

- 1. Restoration of Voting Rights
- 2. Providing information about MacArthur work (reducing jail population), and soliciting feedback on the efforts.
- 3. The following locations based on zip codes and felony jail admissions:
 - a. Lake Worth/Green Acres
 - b. Riviera Beach
 - c. Sand Castle
- 4. Establish a larger group for the Task Force/Team to include the following:
 - a. Re-Entry person (s)
 - b. Victim of Crime
 - c. NAMI
 - d. Mental Health Association
 - Change the name of the Community Engagement Task Force to the Community Engagement Team
