- I. Welcome and opening comments by Chief Tom Ceccarelli, Chairman.
- II. Roll Call
- III. Introduction of Guests
- IV. The agenda and minutes were approved by a motion from Chief Frank Kitzerow and second by Chief Richard Jenkins.
- V. Presentations/Update
  - a. Chenise Bonilla, Manager Criminal Justice Program, Public Safety Department provided an overview of the Re-Entry Program. The program is intended to decrease recidivism, support victims of crime, and increase public safety. Meetings are held quarterly to work on improving the transition process. She also reviewed the events calendar for Second Chance month.

- b. Jonathan Hackley, Senior Criminal Justice Analyst, presented the 2017 Rapid Response Team Annual Report. The purpose of the committee is to review Rapid Response Team cases and reduce process issues. Children three years and younger accounted for the majority of cases. Ms. Shover reminded agencies to submit their Rapid Response Information sheets within 24 hours. She also noted that the committee meets three times a year and recently had a meeting to review the 2018 data.
- c. Katherine Shover, Senior Criminal Justice Analyst, provided information about the transition from summary to incident-based reporting. She also advised members about the new DOJ JAG grant 3% set-aside requirement for NIBRS compliance.
- d. Update PEACE has begun issuing Community ID Cards with support from the City of West Palm Beach. The CJC at the request of the BCC reviewed this issue in 2017 and provided recommendations to the BCC. PEACE held a drive on March 30 and had 1,500 people attend but could only accommodate 300. Chief Mooney noted that the Legal Aid Society manages the program, and ID cards are mailed to applicants within three weeks.

They are currently looking at how calls are handled by 211 and working on a countywide landing page for resources. They will also be working with PSAPs. Chief Kitzerow reported that 80 officers and three analysts have been hired. They are currently working through challenges of having officers in various stages of training. He also thanked everyone for their help.
