 - a. Congratulations to Chief Carl Webb of the South Palm Beach Police Department and Chief Bryan Kummerlen of the West Palm Beach Police Department on their appointments.
- VII. Presentations
 - a. Criminal Justice Academies Overview: Dr. Jeraline Marsh, Career Education Specialist at the Palm Beach County School District, presented a video providing an overview of the Criminal Justice Academies in Palm Beach County. There are currently 5 academies in the county (with another one starting in 2014-2015), and over 500 students. Dr. Marsh discussed the curriculum focus of the academies, their numerous benefits, and many different activities including state competitions. Dr. Marsh remarked that one of the goals of these academic programs is to make sure the students have options when they graduate. She shared examples of the students involved in different activities, and recent graduates employed in one of the local law enforcement agencies.
- VIII. New Business
 - a. SART Walk in Their Shoes: Chief Jenkins recognized Sharon Daugherty and Lt. Chris Keane from PBC SART which was recently awarded outstanding SART by the Florida Council against Sexual Violence. He mentioned some of the accomplishments of the Palm Beach County SART. Chief Jenkins referred to the draft general order for police agencies (included in meeting packet) and opened it up for discussion. Chief Assistant Brian Fernandes of the State Attorney's Office addressed some concerns about the protocol from the perspective of the state attorney's office. Chief Jenkins requested that Assistant State Attorney Michael Kugler provide recommendations to modify the original document. Chief Alexander likewise mentioned some concerns from law enforcement. Chief Kitzerow reiterated the committee's support for SART, but wondered about the desired outcome of the policy as far as the committee is concerned. Chief Alexander reminded that the intent is only to give feedback but not vote on any policy. Chief Jenkins asked the members to provide him with any feedback on the policy, which he will give to SART. Chief Alexander recognized the value of sharing the information with each of the agencies which can make their own decisions as to how to proceed.
