- a. Overview of the Gang Resistance Education and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) Program: *Robert Shirley, Resident Agent in Charge, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives*

Advised that G.R.E.A.T. is an evidenced-based gang and violence prevention program. The program is being taught by Law Enforcement Officers to elementary and middle school aged students. The Palm Beach County G.R.E.A.T. program is under the leadership of the Criminal Justice Commission's Law Enforcement Workgroup. Katherine Hatos (CJC), Marcia Bahia (PBSO) Sgt. Sam Berkman (PBC School Police), and Vince Holmes (ATF) are the coordinators for this program. RAC Shirley recognized that ATF Special Agent Vince Holmes has been instrumental in bringing GREAT training to Palm Beach County. Palm Beach County Information System Services were also recognized for the development of the G.R.E.A.T. website. Palm Beach County is the only location to have a website that is linked directly to the National G.R.E.A.T. program.
