II. **Department Updates**

David Rafaidus PBC Community Services Department representative, reported the following:

• There will be a symposium on domestic violence on February 24th at 1 p.m. It will take place at Community Services.

Carol Clinton, Lake Worth West Resident Planning Group representative, reported the following:

 The new LWW playground is complete. A variety of partners worked with LWWRPG on Build Day, including the KaBOOM group, Parks and Rec. Dept., OCR, PBSO, and over 100 volunteers from the community. Feel free to visit LWW and view the playground.

Joanna Aiken, Solid Waste Authority representative, reported the following:

- There will be a Rebuilding Together of the Palm Beaches/SWA Soiree Resource Depot/SWA Run Away 5k Run and Shred-a-Thon. Organizers are still looking for vendors and sponsors. It will be held on April 11, 2015 and the 5k run starts at 8am at the Solid Waste Authority Administration building.
- Casey Pranckun, PBC Parks and Recreation Dept. representative, reported the following:
- The Gramercy Park project is under construction. A preconstruction meeting took place last month.
- Westgate Park is 75% complete; however, there may be further delays as a portion of the property is not owned by PBC.
