VII. COMMITTEE COMMENTS

Ms. Kyle updated the Committee on the progress and success of the Mentor Protégé program. FDO has awarded an estimated \$112,500,000 for projects. All projects have had SBE participation between 10 and 25% of CM fees.

Ms. Davis Johnson asked Ms. Kyle to share with the Committee the S/M/WBE's that have been successful. Ms. Kyle noted that 77% of the projects were awarded to black male owned CM firms and 23% have been awarded to black female owned firms.

Ms. Kyle also mentioned that even though Federal funded programs are exempt from the program, some projects have included S/M/WBE participation voluntarily.

Ms. Smith updated the Committee on an emergency contract that the contractor could no longer provide the service and that one of our S/MBEs, Restoration Lawn Care, was able to complete the work for Engineering Streetscapes. The Department was pleased of the work and of the program.

Ms. Davis Johnson thanked staff for the work they do on behalf of our certified S/M/WBEs.

Mr. Clinkscale thanked staff for the work they do with the County Departments and the S/M/WBE community.
