

- Project scope: Replacement of two boat ramps, staging docks and fishing dock on Lake Osborne within John Prince Park.
- Boat ramps were originally constructed in 1970. Boat house constructed in 1961.
- Ramps are heavily utilized by fishermen, recreational uses, and boat testing.
- Ramps were repaired multiple times and in need of replacement.

John Prince Park Boat Ramp Replacement



- \$400,000 allocated in FY2020 Surtax funding.
- \$388,200 allocated in Florida Boater Improvement Program funding to supplement Surtax funds.
- StanTec hired as design consultant.
- All Site Construction was lowest responsible bidder.
- Total project cost was \$787,246.
- Construction commenced on Feb. 1, 2021 and is currently in punch list phase.
