The geo-technical report returned good results, showing an existing low water table at 18 feet below grade (BFG), which will reduce the expensive de-watering requirements during construction. The deepest pool level is the diving well, approximately 12 to 13 feet deep. I am scheduling a Design Coordination Meeting with OLC Architects and Park's & Rec to discuss Phase 1 construction, aiming to keep construction expenses at \$20.5M, and to allow future expansion of the building to the east for Phase 2. The FDO Director provided the total project budget of \$23.5M (including both hard and soft costs), as approved in her discussion with BCC.
