Frequently Asked Questions

How much are tickets?

FREE! No tickets are required to attend.

What is happening at the event?

Legends on the Lawn is a free concert series presented by **Palm Beach County Parks & Recreation** and **Nostalgic America Magazine**, bringing live music to the **Canyon Amphitheater** in Boynton Beach. It's a Saturday evening tradition where friends and neighbors gather to enjoy great music in a relaxed, outdoor setting.

Explore the shops and restaurants at **Canyon Town Center** – from supermarkets and boutiques to dining options and more!

Enjoy performances by local musicians and bands playing hits from your favorite decades and genres. Bring your blankets, low-back chairs, and get ready to dance and sing along!

Where does the band perform?

All performances take place on the stage at **Canyon Amphitheater**, located within **Canyon Town Center** in Boynton Beach, FL.

Will the shopping center be open?

Will there be music before or after the band plays?

No. Music is only played during the scheduled performance.

Where can I park?

Parking is available in the shopping plaza during regular business hours. **ADA parking** is available on a **first-come**, **first-served** basis.

Are there any street closures?

There are no planned street closures for this event. However, nearby areas may be affected. Please check local traffic updates for the latest information.

Will restrooms be available?

Yes, public restrooms will be open during the event.

Where are the trash and recycling bins?

Help us keep the venue clean! Please dispose of your trash properly or take it with you. Trash and recycling bins are located throughout the lawn.

Can I bring a tent or canopy?

No. Tents and canopies are not permitted.

Can I bring a grill?

No. Barbecue grills are not allowed.

Can I bring my own seating?

Yes! Please bring low-back or low-profile chairs only.

Can I sit on the sidewalk?

No. Sidewalks must remain clear for emergency access.

Can I bring alcohol?

No. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at the event.

Can I bring my pet?

Yes! Domesticated pets are welcome. All animals must be leashed and kept within six feet of their handler at all times.

Can I bring fireworks?

No. Fireworks, firecrackers, and other flammable or explosive materials are strictly prohibited.

Can I fly a drone at the event?

No. Drones are not allowed at this event.

What if it rains?

This is a **rain or shine** event. In the case of severe weather or lightning, staff may decide to delay or cancel the event. Updates will be posted on social media:
