Mr. Fox read Section R101.4 of the Energy Code and its applicability, which states, "Where, in any specific case, different sections of this code specify different materials, methods of construction or other requirements, the most restrictive shall govern. Where there is a conflict between a general requirement and a specific requirement, the specific requirement shall govern."
