Landscape Service Use in AGR/PUD PRESERVE

1. BCC July 30, 2020 - Adoption of ULDC Amendments

On July 30, 2020 the Board of County Commissioners adopted changes to the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC) relating to a Landscape Service Use with the Agricultural Reserve Planned Unit Development Zoning District (AGR-PUD). The specific language is within the Ordinance link below.

- Ordinance 2020-016, Landscape Service Use in AGR-PUD
- 2. General Information on ordinance provisions and deadlines. Landscape Service uses may be allowed in conjunction with a Wholesale Nursery, within the AGR-PUD Preserve Area, if they are existing and the property is identified within Ordinance 2020-016. Although they may exist they are required to obtain approval from the Development Review Officer (DRO) to come into compliance with the adopted language.

The Applicant shall submit a DRO application, and must be determined to be sufficient within 180 calendar days from **August 3, 2020** which is **January 30, 2021**. Staff will review the application and confirm whether the Applicant has demonstrated that the Landscape Service was in operation prior to Ordinance effective date. Applicants seeking to obtain a DRO approval shall submit the application on the DRO intake dates as described on the **Official Zoning Calendar**. With the final intake date being January 4, 2021.

3. Training 101 Session for Interested Parties on ordinance provisions and deadlines. A virtual training session on the adopted ULDC provisions will be conducted for questions/answers.
