

Summary:

The application is for the existing Canada Court II development. The site was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) in 2011 for a Special Exception for a Type 3 Congregate Living Facility (CLF) with a maximum of 28 residents/beds on 1.48 acres.

The request proposes to abandon the Development Order for the CLF with 25 residents, located in eight buildings on the north and south sites of Prince Drive. This application is being processed concurrently with application DOA-2025-01103 TLC Village, to allow the modification of a previously approved Special Exception for a CLF and Residential Treatment Facility (fka Housing and Treatment of the Chemically Dependent).

The four existing buildings on the north side of Prince Drive are proposed to be added to the TLC Village development. The four existing buildings on the south side of Prince Drive will be reviewed through a future administrative application as a Recovery Community.
