TO ALLOW AN OFFICE/WAREHOUSE COMBINATION on the South 233 feet of the

East 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township

44 South, Range 42 East; less the South 90 feet of East 283 feet of

East 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44
South, Range 42 East; less the South 195 feet of West 50 feet of East
1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44 South,
Range 42 East. Said property located on the west side of Military Trail
(S.R. 809), approximately 200 feet south of Pine Forest Drive,
