ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-90

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED February 17, 1972

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission of Palm Beach County, Florida, in regular session assembled on the 11th day of December, 1969, approved certain zoning changes to become effective upon the filing of County approved Subdivision Plats and this plat was filed as of the 25th day of January, 1972:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 17th day of February, 1972, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

That portion of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, lying South and West of the Seaboard Airline Railroad right-of-way, less the right-of-way of Military Trail is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to M-1 Industrial District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Weaver, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
