ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-95

MODIFYING PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT
PARKING REQUIREMENTS

ADOPTED February 17, 1972

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,
in regular session assembled this the 17th day of February, 1972,
adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant
to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691,
Special Laws of Florida 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of
Florida 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida 1970:

Modify, SECTION 14-26 PLANNED-UNIT DEVELOPMENT
CONDITIONAL USES AND REQUIREMENTS, paragraph 5
to read as follows:

A minimum of two (2) parking spaces per dwelling unit
shall be required; however, one and one-half (1 1/2)
spaces per dwelling unit may be constructed and the
~~area required for the additional one-half (1/2) space~~
per dwelling unit shall be set aside and indicated on
the master plan as future parking area to remain as
open green space until the need for it occurs. Such
need to be an administrative determination by the Zon-
ing Director based on an inspection of the traffic and
parking facilities of the project, statistical data com-
piled to determine additional parking needs, and other
information submitted by the residents of the project
and appropriate governmental agencies.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner

Lytal, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded
by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the
