ZONING RESOLUTION NO. R-72-220

MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

ADOPTED April 20, 1972

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission of Palm Beach County, Florida, in regular session assembled on the 5th day of May, 1966, approved certain zoning changes to become effective upon the filing of County approved Subdivision Plats and this Plat was filed as of the 28th day of December, 1971.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 20th day of April, 1972, adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution No. 3-57, pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida, 1957, Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida, 1959, and Chapter 70-863, Special Laws of Florida, 1970:

Plat No. 12, Forest Hill Village in Section 14, Township 44 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 29, Page 132 is hereby rezoned from an A-1 Agricultural District to an R-2 Multiple Family Dwelling District.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Johnson, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
