

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 307

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-42 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 May 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of May, 1973, that petition No. 73-42, the petition of THE UNITED PENTECOSTAL CHURCH OF WEST PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, INC., by the Reverend Eugene Harvey, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CHURCH on the East 120 feet of the South 404 feet of the North 5/8 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, Section 8, Township 44 South, Range 43 East; subject to existing easements and road rights-of-way. Said property located at the southwest corner of the intersection of Prairie Road and Palmarita Road in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was denied.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


