

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 309

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-46 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 24 May 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of May, 1973, that petition No. 73-46, the petition of IMMEUBLES SIMARD, INC., by Gilles Simard, President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of Tract 20, Block 81, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53. Said property located approximately 1/2 mile east of State Road No. 7 (U.S. No. 441) and approximately 600 feet south of L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 48, was approved as advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Culpepper, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


