## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of June, 1973, that petition No. 73-71, the petition of SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH CO., by Roger W. Strickland, Agent, for a SPECIAL.EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A TELEPHONE DECENTRALIZED TOLL OFFICE on the South 600 feet of the East 319 feet of the East 1/2 of Lot 4, Block 4, Plat 1, Palm Beach Plantations, in Section 7, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 10, page 20. Said property located at the northeast corner of Forest Hill Boulevard and Jewell Lane in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

(1) A revised Site Plan to be submitted to the Department showing the correct setback from Forest Hill Boulevard and the

elimination of parking spaces in the future right-of-way for Jewell Lane;

(2) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the developer shall dedicate, to Palm Beach County, the additional right-of-way required to provide for a one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way for Forest Hill Boulevard.
