

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 403

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-86 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 June 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of June, 1973, that petition No. 73-86, the petition of M & J INVESTMENTS, INC., by M.M. Jamison, President, for a SPEICAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A COMMERCIAL KENNEL AND STABLES on that part of Section 26 and 35, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, lying North of Dyer Boulevard, West of Haverhill Road and South of Canal EPB9A, said canals being works of Northern Palm Beach County Water Control District. Said property located on the north side of Dyer Boulevard and on the west side of Haverhill Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

- (1) Commercial kennel and stable approval recommended to run concurrent with lease which expires March 22, 1974.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Culpepper , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


