## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-116 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

MOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973 , that petition No. 73-1.16, the petition of THE WATERGATE COMPANY by Frank L. Glusman, Partner, for the REZOMING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMEKCIAL DISTRICT, of a certain parcel in Section 25, Township 47 South, Range 41 East, being a part of Tract 55, 56 and abandoned 15 foot wide roadway on South side of Tract 56 of Florida Fruit Lands Companys Subdivision No. 2 of Section 25 recorded in Plat Book 1, page 102, Sheet No. 4, more particularly described as follows: from the intersection of the-Westerly right-of-way line of State Road No. 7 with the South line of said Section 25 , as same is shown on plat of Watergate recorded in Plat Book 29, page 29, run thence North $88^{\circ} 54$ ' 16" West along the South linc of Section 25 as shown on said Plat Book 29, page 29, a distance of 320.00 feet to the Southeast corner and

Said property located on the.west side of State Road No. 7 approximately . 3 mile north of Broward County Line, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:
(1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the developer shall dedicate, the additional ninety-nine (99) feet required to provide for the ultimate right-of-way for State Road No. 7;
(2) The developer shall construct the turning lanes as shown on the site plan.
