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RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session July, 1973 this 26th day of , that petition No. 73-47, the petition of ARTHUR FROGEL for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL, MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) IN PART AND IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT IN PART TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A MOTEL on Lot 28, less the South 245 feet of the West 180 feet and less the right-of-way for 10th Avenue North, and Lot 23, less the right-of-way for 10th Avenue North and subject to the drainage easement on the East 25 feet of Lot 9, Model Land Company's Subdivision of Section 20, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 79. proper-ty located on the north side of Tenth Avenue North approximately 3/4 mile east of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits the developer shall dedicate to Palm Beach County the additional fourteen (14) feet required for the right-of-way for 10th Avenue North;
- (2) the developer shall construct the required turning lane onto 10th Avenue North;
- (3) there shall be no access to the site from Boutwell Road.
