RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

PIGNATO for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAY CARE CENTER on Lots 7 and 8, Block 2, Laguana Park No. 2, less the East 10 feet, Section 7, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 65, Said property located on the west side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) approximately .3 mile north of Forest Hill Boulevard in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

(1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits, the developer shall dedicate, to Palm Beach County, the additional rightof-way required to provide for a one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way for Congress Avenue.
