

RESOLUTION NO. R-73- 462

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION'

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning, Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-132 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of July, 1973, that petition No. 73-132, the petition of THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY by Lake Lytal, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT, of all of Section 16, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located approximately 400 feet south of Forest Hill Boulevard approximately 900 feet east of Florida's Turnpike, containing 655 acres, more or less, was approved as advertised.
