OFFICE AND DISPATCH INCLUDING CASTING AND STORAGE OF CONCRETE SEPTIC TANKS AND COMPONENTS on the East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of Tracts 14 and 15, Subdivision of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 44 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 3, page 10; reserving 100 feet for State Road right-of-way on the North line of the centerline and the North 40 feet of the above described parcel for County road right-of-way.
