RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-135 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 September 1973.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of September, 1973, that petition No. 73-135, the petition of PHYLLIS B. MEYER for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN ANTIQUE AUTO PAINT AND BODY REPAIR on Lots 8 and 9, Block 1, Kenmont, in Section 9, Township 46 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 20, page 65. Said property located on the north side of Bond Way approximately 100 feet east of U.S. No. 1 in a CG-General Commercial District, was denied as advertised.
