Alexander, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION AND CLUB FACILITIES on the South 350 feet of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 26, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, less the West 60 feet thereof claimed by Lake Worth Drainage District. Said property located on the east side of L.W.D.D. Equalizing Canal No. 3 approximately 220 feet south of Elmhurst Street in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following special condition:

(1) Ingress and egress to the property shall be limited to Okeechobee Boulevard.
