RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of September, 1973, that petition No. 73-155, the petition of SANTO BUCCAFUSCHI for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAY CARE CENTER on Lot 4, Block 1, Bermuda Park Addition No. 1 in Section 17, Township 44 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 50. Said property located on the east side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) approximately .4 mile south of Forest Hill Boulevard in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

(1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits the developer shall dedicate to Palm Beach County, the additional right-of-way to provide for a one hundred twenty (120) foot right-of-way for Congress Avenue and the forty (40) feet for a limited access road.
