RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County **Commissioners**, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating **to** zoning; and

DUDA & SONS, INC. for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW FARM LABOR QUARTERS on the West 1605 feet of the South 493 feet of the North 598 feet of Section 15, Township 44 South, Range 37 East. Said property located approximately 1.5 miles southwest of the intersection of State Road 80 and Duda Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

- (1) Submission of written approval from the Health Department for the labor camp operation;
- (2) Proof that adequate sewer and water service, approved by the Health Department, will be provided for the project.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Weaver who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren , and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
