BARGE for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE RETAIL SALES OF RECREATIONAL VEHILCES on the following described parcel of land: beginning at a point of intersection at the centerline of State Road 4, that is U.S. Highway #1, with the South line of the Northwest 1/2 of Section 4, Township 42 South, Range 43 East; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of said Highway, a distance of 1950 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence continue along said centerline 200 feet; thence Westerly, parallel to the South line of said quarter section, a distance of 361.74 feet; thence Southerly at right angles a distance of 195.61 feet; thence Easterly, parallel to the.
