RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the gove body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session November, 1973 29th day of , that petition No. 73-234, the petition of RINKER MATERIALS CORP., by H. F. Bowman, Vice Fresident, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IG-GENERAL INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CONCRETE MIXING PLANT AND ACCESSORY FACILITIES on the West 490.00 feet Of the East 820.00 feet of Tract 19, Block 8, and the West 490.00 feet of the East 820.00 feet of Tract 18, Block 8, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 31, Township 43 -South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46; also, that certain East-West 30.00 footroad right-of-way (now abandoned) lying adjacent to Tracts 1.8 and 19; less, however, the road right-of-way for Southern Boulevard Said property located on the north side of Southern Boulevard (S.R., 80) approximately 1/2 mile east of State Road No. 7 (U.S. 441),

was approved as advertised subject to the following special conditions:

- Developer shall construct at his expense the left turning lane for ingress to the property;
- 2) Developer shall construct at his expense the right turning lane for deceleration foringress from the property;

- 4) Developer shall provide an opaque buffer along the east property line.
