## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-247 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 4 January 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session day of January, 1974 , that petition this 4th No. 73-247, the petition of ROSA TUSA VASSILEV for a SPECIAL EXCEP-TION TO ALLOW THE EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF EXTRACTIVE MATERIAL on the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the South 1/3 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the East 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the West 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southea'st 1/4 and the South 1/3 of the East 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the South 1/3 of the West 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 in Section 20, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, less the South 481 feet thereof. - 4) Prior to any excavation the developer shall execute a
  Unity of Title document.
