Sly, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of all of Tract 66, Block 5, together with that part of Tract 75 (lying North of Southern Boulevard ultimate right-of-way) according to the plat of Addition Number 1 of Boulevard Park in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 14, page 18. Said property located approximately 50 feet north of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80) on the east side of 65th Way North (Tall Pines Road), was denied as advertised.
