

RESOLUTION NO. R-74-188

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-1 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 February 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of February, 1974, that petition No. 74-1, the petition of DRUMMOND ENTERPRISES, INC., by James H. Watson, Executive Vice President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT, of Tract 3, less the South 400.00 feet, Block 79, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Section 20, Township 47 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 53. Said property located 1/4 mile south of Boca Raton West Road (S.R. 808) and 650 feet west of Florida's Turnpike, was approved as advertised.

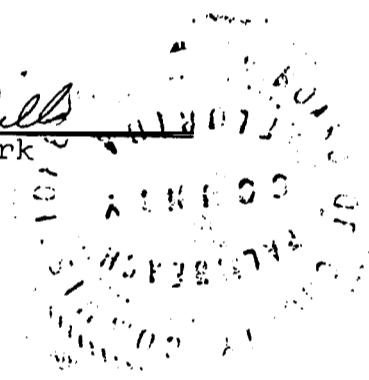
