NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of March, 1974 , that petition No. 74-13, the petition of WALLACE HAM for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT AND A SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A SEWERAGE TREATMENT PLANT, on the West 1/4 of Section 13, Township 42 South, Range 41 East, less the North 100 feet of the South 687.92 feet of the West 1/4 and the West 40 feet of the South 587.92 feet of Section 13; subject to an easement deed over the South 40 feet of the West 1/4 as recorded in Deed Book 974, page Said property located on the north and south sides of Lake Park West Road Extended (S.R. 809A) approximately 3/4 mile west of State Road No. 7, was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:

- 1) Prior to the issuance of any building permit the developer shall file a boundary plat;
- 2) The developer shall construct, at his expense, a two (2) lane facility for Lake Park West Road.
