

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 281

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-30 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 28 March 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of March, 1974, that petition No. 74-30, the petition of WILLIAM H. WHITNEY, D.V.M., and RIGHT-ON CORP. by William J. Bosso, President, for the REZONING, FROM RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT TO AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT of the South 708 feet of the North 2906 feet of that part of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 together with the South 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 34, Township 40 South, Range 41 East, lying North of State Road No. 706, less the West 622 feet thereof. Said property located approximately 200 feet North of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706) and approximately 4 3/4 miles West of Florida's Turnpike, was approved and advertised.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner **Lytal**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Warren, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


The Chairman thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this 16th day of April, 1974, confirming action of 28 March 1974.
