## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-80 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 June 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this. 27th day of June, 1974, that petition No. 74-80, the petition of LACY EVERETT for the REZONING, FROM AGAGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the South 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 13, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, less the Northeast 1/4 thereof as more particularly described in Official Record Book 739, page 782, dated July 28, 1969. Said property located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809) approximately 1/4 mile north of Atlantic Avenue (Delray Road West, S.R. 806), was approved as amended to include a Planned Commercial Development, subject to the following special condition:

1) Prior to the issuance of any building permits
the petitioner shall dedicate to Palm Beach County
the additional right-of-way required for completing
a one hundred (100) foot half section for Military
Trail (S.R. 809) as measured from the centerline.
