NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMIS-SIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of June, 1974 , that petition No. 74-76, the petition of SAUL DUMAS for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART AND RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) IN PART TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT AND THE FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT INCLUDING A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT on the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 less the North 100 feet and the West 30 feet thereof in Section 25, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the south side of Lake Worth Road (S.R. 802) approximately 1/4 mile east of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised, subject to the following special conditions:
