RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

INFANTE for the REZONING, ROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of a parcel of land situated, lying and being in the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 47 South, Range 41 East, more fully described as follows: beginning at the intersection of the Westerly rightof-way line of State Road No. 7 as now constructed and in use, with the North line of the Hillsboro Canal Reservation; thence Westerly along said North line which forms an angle of 89° 0.3' 58" as measured from North to West with said Westerly right-of-way line of State Road No. 7, a distance of 380.69 feet; thence Westerly along a line which forms an included angle of 161° 26' 00" with last described course, a distance of 20.54 feet; thence Northerly along a line which forms an included angle of 109° 30' 02" with last described course, a distance of 986.94 feet; thence Easterly along a line being at

right angles to last described course, a distance of 400.00 feet to a point on said Westerly right-of-way line of State Road No. 7; thence Southerly along said Westerly right-of-way line, being at right angles to last described course, a distance of 1000.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.
