

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 544

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

Kneen, Attorney, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE EXPANSION OF A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT on the North 600.00 feet of the South 681.00 feet of the West 1903.53 feet of the East 1953.53 feet of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 23, Township 43 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the north side of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704) approximately 1/2 mile west of Haverhill Road in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised.


The Chairman thereupon declared the resolution duly passed and adopted this **9th** day of **July**, 1974, confirming action of 27 June 1974.
