

RESOLUTION NO. R-74-701

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-98 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 July 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of July, 1974, that petition No. 74-98, the petition of VILLAGE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL, INC., by Lela Louise Hall, Vice President and Treasurer, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PRIVATE SCHOOL on a parcel of land lying in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 5, Township 42 South, Range 43 East, being more particularly described as follows: the Northerly 295.16 feet of the Westerly 295.16 feet of the Easterly 695.16 feet of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 5 aforesaid. Said property located on the south side of West Edgewater Drive approximately 400 feet west of Prosperity Farms Road and approximately .5 mile north of P.G.A. Boulevard in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was denied as advertised.
