

RESOLUTION NO. R-74-702

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-56 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 July 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of July, 1974, that petition No. 74-56, the petition of DIXIE ASPHALT COMPANY, INC., by Jav S. Eaton, Secretary, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW EXCAVATION AND REMOVAL OF SAND on Tracts 29 and 30, Block 6, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3 in Sections 32 and 33, Township 43 South, Range 42 East as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 46. Said property located approximately 150 feet east of Benoist Farms Road and approximately .2 mile north of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80) in an IL-Light Industrial District, was approved as advertised.
