

RESOLUTION NO. R-74- 771

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners; **as** the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 70-863, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1970, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 74-129 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 August 1974.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this **29th** day of August, 1974, that petition No. 74-129, the petition of ANDERS I. JOHNSON for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAY CARE CENTER on Lot 3, Drew Manor, in Section 18, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 36. Said property located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) and Drew Way in an RS-Residential Single Family District, was approved as advertised.


